As We Gather ... What's in it for me? That is often the world's question and ours too. Jesus comes as the Good Shepherd to battle the enemies of sin and death and to protect and defend us. His sheep. 





WORDS OF INSTITUTION



Pastor: The peace of the Lord be with you always.






