## **INVOCATION and OPENING SENTENCES**

- People: we confess that we have neglected to hear Your Word. We have not conformed our lives to it in what we think, say, or do. We have not loved You wholeheartedly and we have failed to use our Spiritgiven gifts to build one another up in the Body of Christ. Forgive us and turn us toward Your Word that we may continually delight in You and Your lifegiving promises.
- Pastor: Jesus told the people of His hometown "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing" (*Luke 4:21*). Sadly, the people allowed their own reason to get in the way of their faith and they disbelieved. The truth has not changed in all the centuries that have passed since. It is by grace we are saved, and by faith we have been forgiven. In the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.



  - Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.


