The Baptism Of Our Lord

January 7, 2024

As We Gather Today we recall an 'old' event in history, the Baptism of Our Lord. God's Word teaches us that it is also a 'current' event producing a new creation and new life for each person who is baptized into Jesus Christ. In the beginning God was pleased with His new creation---light (Genesis 1:4); at Jesus' Baptism the Father was pleased with Jesus, His Son (Mark 1:11); and at our Baptism into Christ, we are pleasing to God and therefore are able to "walk in newness of life" (Romans 6:4).

Attention Visitors We celebrate the sacrament of Holy Communion this morning. This holy meal is intended for Christians who acknowledge their need of God's forgiveness in their lives. The Bible teaches that Christ's body and blood are received with the elements of bread and wine and that Christians need to examine themselves before receiving this holy meal. (1Cor. 10 & 11). This meal further expresses a unity of faith as we gather at one table to receive the assurance of God's forgiveness through the body and blood of our Lord in the sacrament. We welcome baptized Christians to commune with us, those who believe and confess this same faith and understanding of the sacrament and of the Christian life. Persons who desire to receive grape juice select from the darker glasses. If you have any further questions concerning the sacrament, please ask to speak to the Pastor.



People: we confess that we have not been faithful creatures; we have rebelled in our thinking, we have spoken in anger, and we have acted without regard to Your will or reign. In Your mercy You have graciously joined us to the Body of Christ, and for His sake, forgive us our sins. By Your Holy Spirit, turn our hearts to love You and our neighbors with all that we are and have.

Pastor:

"The death Christ died He died to sin, once for all, but the life He lives He lives to God. So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus." (Romans 6:10-11) By your baptismal faith in Jesus Christ, all your sins have been forgiven. In the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.



And he will come again with glory to judge both the living and the dead, whose kingdom will have no end.





People: And also with you.


