<u>As We Gather</u> Christ the King Sunday is that of the Fulfillment. Today, the Word of God focuses our attention on the end of days, when the Lord Jesus will come again "in clouds with great power and glory" (*Mark 13:26*). Waiting, watchfully, for God's mercy on that blessed day, the Holy Church on earth keeps the faith, and remains in the love of God patiently showing mercy to all who struggle with doubt and sin (*cf. Jude 20-25*).






