#### **FOURTH SUNDAY IN LENT**

March 27, 2022

As We Gather If you were challenged to condense all of Scripture into one word, what word would that word be? If you were to choose a single word that summarized all sixty-six books of the Bible, what word would you choose? What particular word would you say best describes God's work in both the Old and New Testaments? A good candidate is the word *reconcile*. We see this word in our Epistle reading today in 2 Corinthians 5:19. "In Christ God was reconciling the world to Himself." During this season of Lent, we remember our need for reconciliation as people who have sinned and are by nature alienated from God. Remember also the good news that, in Christ, God has reconciled us to Himself.

For Your Son has suffered for me, Giv'n Himself to rescue me, Died to save me and restore me, Reconciled and set me free. Jesus' cross alone can vanquish These dark fears and soothe this anguish.




