

Strengthen our love for our brothers and sisters in the faith. We confess that we have not boldly proclaimed our faith to the people we meet in our neighborhoods, at work, and in school. Grant us courage to use the opportunities You provide so that many may come to faith in our risen Lord.
- Pastor: When Jesus appeared to the disciples on Easter evening He told them, "If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them" (*John 20:23a*). God promises to forgive the sins of all who come to Him in faith and repentance. For Jesus' sake God has removed your sins as far as the east is from the west and given you a fresh start. In the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.



AFFIRMATION OF FAITH


