THE DAY OF PENTECOST

June 5, 2022

As We Gather The Scriptures share many accounts of God coming down to earth. From the moment of creation when “the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters” (*Genesis 1:2*), God has come down to this favored planet many times and in many ways. On Pentecost, God the Holy Spirit came down to earth in a most dramatic way, fulfilling the promise of His descent that Jesus had made to His disciples. That blessed Spirit continues to come among God’s people, calling, gathering, enlightening, and sanctifying them. As we gather, we witness to that Spirit at work among and through us.

Attention Visitors We celebrate the sacrament of Holy Communion this morning. This holy meal is intended for Christians who acknowledge their need of God’s forgiveness in their lives. The Bible teaches that Christ’s body and blood are received with the elements of bread and wine and that Christians need to examine themselves before receiving this holy meal. (1Cor. 10 & 11). This meal further expresses a unity of faith as we gather at one table to receive the assurance of God’s forgiveness through the body and blood of our Lord in the sacrament. We welcome baptized Christians to commune with us, those who believe and confess this same faith and understanding of the sacrament and of the Christian life. Persons who desire to receive grape juice select from the darker glasses. If you have any further questions concerning the sacrament, please ask to speak to the Pastor.

OPENING VERSES

Pastor: On Pentecost, in the year our Lord Jesus rose from death, the Holy Spirit came to the apostles with great signs and gifts. That same Spirit is with each of us, for without His aid we cannot have sustaining faith in our Savior. God's presence with us, though, reminds us that He knows everything about us, including every sinful thought, word, and deed. In Psalm 139 David contemplates this truth as a blessing in our lives. We read it responsively as we prepare for our time of confession.

Pastor: Christ has ascended to heaven and sent His Holy Spirit to lead us and guide us. Our Lord did not abandon us but continues to bless us in marvelous ways. For His sake, God forgives you all your sins. In the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.
