People: **Open to me the gates of righteousness, that I may enter through them and give thanks to the Lord.**

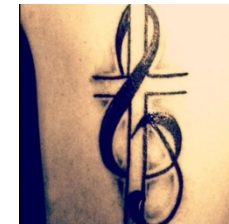
Pastor: This is the gate of the Lord; the righteous shall enter through it.

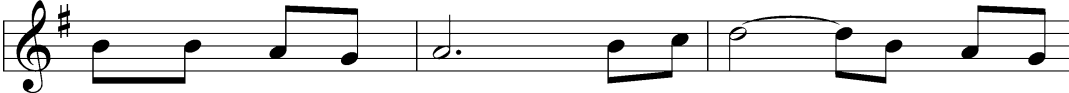
