As We Gather Today is a day of celebration! Jesus is alive! He is risen indeed. This fact informs all of our lives---if God can raise Jesus from the dead, He can bring life to my situation; He can take away my fear of death. So this day, we rejoice. We celebrate Jesus, no longer dead, but alive.

Attention Visitors We celebrate the sacrament of Holy Communion this morning. This holy meal is intended for Christians who acknowledge their need of God's forgiveness in their lives. The Bible teaches that Christ's body and blood are received with the elements of bread and wine and that Christians need to examine themselves before receiving this holy meal. (*1Cor. 10 & 11*). This meal further expresses a unity of faith as we gather at one table to receive the assurance of God's forgiveness through the body and blood of our Lord in the sacrament. We welcome baptized Christians to commune with us, those who believe and confess this same faith and understanding of the sacrament and of the Christian life. Persons who desire to receive grape juice select from the darker glasses. If you have any further questions concerning the sacrament, please ask to speak to the Pastor.

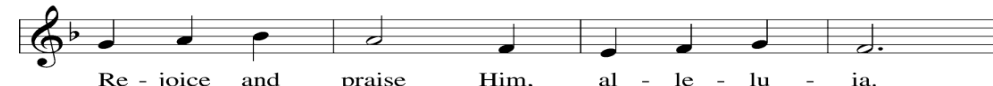





IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION!- Beginning April 1st, the kitchen will be off limits to everyone due to the work that needs to be done. The fridge/ freezer unit needs to be moved away from the wall and located somewhere else in the kitchen and plugged in to prevent any kind of foot traffic. There will be an “environmental curtain” temporarily installed to prevent dust and other irritants into the air. Fans will also be used and need to run all night. The work should last a week.
