**As We Gather** We know that living a faithful life isn't easy, especially with a challenging culture and world around us. However, we are blessed with the Lord's continued encouragement in our pilgrimage, just as others in Scripture experienced. Amid wickedness and destruction, God would encourage Habakkuk to remain steadfast in his duty. Through Paul's letter, God would affirm Timothy in his service, encouraging him to remain steadfast in the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. Jesus also gives His disciples and us encouragement in our daily living through forgiveness and an increase of faith as we place ourselves where His Spirit works through His Word and Means of Grace. In that continued encouragement, may we give thanks for His ever-present grace and mercy as we live humbly and faithfully in His name and to His glory.

**Attention Visitors** We celebrate the sacrament of Holy Communion this morning. This holy meal is intended for Christians who acknowledge their need of God's forgiveness in their lives. 


