As We Gather In both the Old Testament and Gospel readings, cities are mentioned. Isaiah spoke a comforting word to those who loved and mourned for Jerusalem, a city filled with struggles to remain faithful to God. Jesus sent out the seventy-two to the towns and cities He was about to enter; some would welcome Jesus' messengers, others would not. Jesus even speaks "Woes" to two cities for not repenting and for rejecting His messengers. Our cities, too, struggle; pockets of faithfulness to Jesus, where there is a willingness to repent---turn to God---again and again exist. Yet there is also, at times, an almost overwhelming sense that faith is scarce in our cities and repentance is the last thing some would want. Still, God is faithful. He calls us to rejoice, because He comforts us like a mother comforts a child. He calls us to rejoice, because in Word and Sacrament again today His reign comes near to us and we are reminded that our names are written in heaven. Yes, even in the cities in which we live, God sends us to be like a river of peace flowing in their midst.



Pastor: God hears a heartfelt confession. Jesus laid down His life as God's


response. He took our sins and our falleness upon Himself to free us from sin's debt. By your faith in God's Son, all your sins have been forgiven!






