Patients in United States hospitals, surgery centers and emergency rooms require about 30,000 units of red blood cells daily.

To be a donor, you must be at least 16 years old, (there is no upper age restriction). 16- and 17-year-olds do require written parental permission. For whole blood donations, your last donation must have been at least eight weeks ago. And you must be healthy the day you donate.

Summer camp will be held Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 8:30-11:30am.


