June 18, 2023

As We Gather Teaching. Healing. Proclaiming the Good News. Like a compassionate Shepherd longing to gather His scattered sheep, Jesus came to reconcile people to His Father. When Jesus sent His disciples as laborers into His harvest field, He guaranteed that His reconciling work would continue even after He physically departed the earth. Wherever Jesus' Word is proclaimed and His sacraments are administered, He continues to gather souls into His kingdom. He does that for us in worship today! Having gathered us in His name, taught us with His Word, and healed us by His Supper, He will then send us out into His harvest field. We welcome baptized Christians to commune with us, those who believe and confess this same faith and understanding of the sacrament and of the Christian life. 





# **CONFESSION OF FAITH (NICENE CREED)**

#### WORDS OF INSTITUTION




