As We Gather God has a plan for us. His plan is that marriage between a man and a woman is to be lifelong, and that a loving family is the environment in which He intends children to grow up and mature. Jesus tells us in our Gospel for today that it is sin and human pride that is at the root of marriage and family problems. Indeed, He came into our world to forgive our sins, to heal us from the illness of sin, and to restore us t full life in His name. As members of His family, we are encouraged to do all that we can to strengthen the human family, that our heavenly Father may be honored.

Attention Visitors We celebrate the sacrament of Holy Communion this morning. This holy meal is intended for Christians who acknowledge their need of God’s forgiveness in their lives. The Bible teaches that Christ’s body and blood are received with the elements of bread and wine and that Christians need to examine themselves before receiving this holy meal. (1Cor. 10 & 11). This meal further expresses a unity of faith as we gather at one table to receive the assurance of God’s forgiveness through the body and blood of our Lord in the sacrament. We welcome baptized Christians to commune with us, those who believe and confess this same faith and understanding of the sacrament and of the Christian life. 




