THE ASCENSION OF OUR LORD

May 16, 2021

As We Gather Where is your focus? We easily focus on the day-to-day problems we have. Hard day on the job? Family life is falling apart? Friends seem distant? When we focus on what is happening now, we can feel so very alone. Then we come to today, the Ascension, when Jesus leaves His disciples behind to go back to heaven. Even Jesus abandons us?! Except . . . it is not what it appears. The Ascension is not Jesus abandoning us. He goes to heaven, where He fills the whole universe! He has removed His visible presence from us, but He is still present. He is not on vacation, either. Jesus reigns over the entire universe for the good of His people, the Church. Shift your focus; it is not about what is here. Put your focus on things above, where Jesus reigns for you.

Attention Visitors We celebrate the sacrament of Holy Communion this morning. This holy meal is intended for Christians who acknowledge their need of God's forgiveness in their lives. The Bible teaches that Christ's body and blood are received with the elements of bread and wine and that Christians need to examine themselves before receiving this holy meal. (1Cor. 10 & 11). This meal further expresses a unity of faith as we gather at one table to receive the assurance of God's forgiveness through the body and blood of our Lord in the sacrament. +THE WORD OF GOD+

FIRST LESSON *Acts 1:1–11*

(Jesus goes to heaven, and He will return as He left.)

In the first book, O Theophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach, ² until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commands through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. ³ He presented himself alive to them after his suffering by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God.⁴ And while staying with them he ordered them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, “you heard from me; ⁵ for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.”⁶ So when they had come together, they asked him, “Lord, will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?” ⁷ He said to them, “It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority. ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” ⁹ And when he had said these things, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. ¹⁰ And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, ¹¹ and said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven.”




