THE DAY OF PENTECOST/CONFIRMATION

May 28, 2023

As We Gather This day was foreshadowed when the Spirit rested on Eldad and Medad long ago (Numbers 11:26). This day was promised by Jesus, “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth” (Acts 1:8). This day was fulfilled on that Pentecost, when, with tongues as of fire, the apostles spoke the Gospel of Jesus to all those who had gathered in Jerusalem in their own languages. This day is fulfilled among us as we sing of Jesus, as we listen to the Scriptures, as we hear the Gospel proclaimed in our own language, and as God sends us out to be witnesses in the places we live and visit. Hail thee festival day! As promised long ago, the Holy Spirit breathes Jesus’ life among us!

Attention Visitors We celebrate the sacrament of Holy Communion this morning. This holy meal is intended for Christians who acknowledge their need of God’s forgiveness in their lives. The Bible teaches that Christ’s body and blood are received with the elements of bread and wine and that Christians need to examine themselves before receiving this holy meal. (1Cor. 10 & 11). This meal further expresses a unity of faith as we gather at one table to receive the assurance of God’s forgiveness through the body and blood of our Lord in the sacrament. We welcome baptized Christians to commune with us, those who believe and confess this same faith and understanding of the sacrament and of the Christian life. Persons who desire to receive grape juice select from the darker glasses. If you have any further questions concerning the sacrament, please ask to speak to the Pastor.

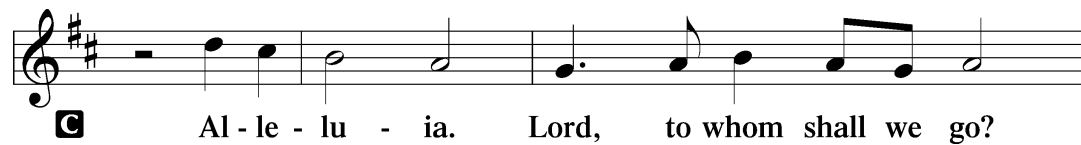


